Projekat:

Pokreni se!

Cilj projekta: Zapošljavanje i samozapošljavanje žrtava mina i poboljšanje njihovog ekonomsko-socijalnog statusa

Rezultati:

- Obuhvaćeno ukupno 101 korisnik/korisnica;
- Realizovani sastanci sa predstavnicima lokalne vlasti i organizacijama civilnog društva koje se bave pitanjima osoba sa invaliditetom u 7 opština Republike Srpske;
- Odabrani aplikanti iz 7 opština RS (Banja Luka, Mrkonjić Grad, Kotor Varoš, Laktaši, Ribnik, Šipovo, Čelinac) koji su aplicirali na javni poziv za žrtve mina i dodjelu granta za pokretanje biznisa;
- Realizovan trening na temu "Izrada, vođenje i praćenje biznis planova iz oblasti voćarstva, stočarstva i poljoprivrede";
- Pružena savjetodavna pomoć direktnim korisnicima vezano za kreiranje biznis ideje;
- Odabrano 13 najuspješnijih biznis planova i finansijska podrška za njihovu realizaciju;
- U okviru finansiranja 13 biznis planova nabavljeno: 2 motokultivatora, 1 kosačica, 1 trimer, 1 dodatak za motokultivator, 1 motorna pila, te 3 plastenika, 13 košnica za pčele i 1 sistem za navodnjavanje,
- Nabavljen značajan i raznovrstan stočni fond;
- Stvoreni uslovi za samozapošljavanje žrtava mina i članova njihovih porodica;
- Dat doprinos smanjenju siromaštva 13 porodica;
- Realizovana promocija projekta i njegovih rezultata putem internet stranice Udruženja i novinskih članaka.

"U okviru projekta sam dobio plastenik. Planiram saditi papriku, paradajz i krastavce. To za moju porodicu znači puno jer ćemo jedan dio povrća koristiti za svoje potrebe, a drugi prodavati. Na jesen sam planirao posijati špinat, luk i salatu. Ovaj plastenik će poboljšati finansijsku situaciju u mojoj porodici jer ćemo moći ostvariti neku zaradu. Move!

Goal of the project: Employment and self-employment of landmine survivors and improvement of their economic and social status

Results:

- A total of 101 beneficiaries involved;
- Organized meetings with representatives of the local authorities and civil society organizations in charge of issues of persons with disabilities in 7 municipalities of Republika Srpska;
- Selected applicants from 7 municipalities in RS (Banja Luka, Mrkonjić Grad, Kotor Varoš, Laktaši, Ribnik, Šipovo, Čelinac) who applied to the public call for the land mine survivors and allocation of the grant for starting a small business;
- Organized training entitled "Creating, Implementing and Monitoring of a Business Plans in the Area of Fruit-growing, Cattle-breeding and Agriculture";
- Provided counseling and support to direct beneficiaries for creating a business idea;
- Selected 13 most successful business plans and financial support for their implementation;
- Within financing of 13 business plans the following equipment was procured: 2 motor-cultivators, 1 mower, 1 trimmer, 1 addition for motor-cultivators, 1 motor file, 3 greenhouses, 13 beehives and 1 watering system,
- Provided substantial and diversified cattle fund;
- Created conditions for self-employment of landmine survivors and members of their families;
- Contributed to poverty reduction of 13 families;
- The project and its results promoted on the web-site of the Association and newspaper articles.
