Projekat:

Unaprjeđenje kvaliteta podrške u provedbi inkluzivnog obrazovanja u Kantonu Sarajevo

Cilj projekta: Unaprijediti inkluzivno obrazovanje u predškolskom, osnovnom i srednjem obrazovanju u Kantonu Sarajevo

Partner: Ministarstvo za obrazovanje, nauku i mlade Kantona Sarajevo

Rezultati:

- Obuhvaćeno ukupno 684 korisnika/korisnica;
- Formiran ekspertni tim od 5 članova za izradu instrumentarija/upitnika za kvalitativnu i kvantitativnu analizu u inkluzivnom obrazovanju;
- Kreirane 3 vrste upitnika kao instrumenti za praćenje inkluzivnog obrazovanja u Kantonu Sarajevo;
- Razvijen i usvojen inovativni model praćenja u okviru inkluzivnog obrazovanja;
- Instaliran softver u Udruženju "Život sa Down sindromom" sa podacima djece sa posebnim obrazovnim potrebama;
- Kreiran Izvještaj o stanju i potrebama djece s posebnim obrazovnim potrebama u inkluzivnom obrazovanju u Kantonu Sarajevo;
- Realizovan jednostavni izlet za 138 učenika u okviru kojeg je realizovano 5 edukativnih radionica sa djecom iz osnovnih škola Kantona Sarajevo;
- Realizovana javna debata predstavnika relevantnog ministarstva, fakulteta, škola, specijalnih ustanova i organizacija civilnog društva, a koja je unaprijedila saradnju u rješavanju problema djece s poteškoćama u učenju;
- Realizovano javno predstavljanje projekta i rezultata koji se odnose na Izvještaj o stanju i potrebama djece s posebnim potrebama u inkluzivnom odgojno obrazovnom procesu.

Project:

Improvement of Quality of Support in Implementation of Inclusive Education in the Sarajevo Canton

Goal of the project: Improve inclusive education in preschool, primary and secondary education in the Sarajevo Canton

Partner: Ministry of Education, Science and Youth of the Sarajevo Canton

Results:

- A total of 684 beneficiaries involved;
- Established an expert team of 5 members to create instruments i.e. questionnaire for qualitative and quantitative analysis in inclusive education;
- Created 3 types of the questionnaire as instruments for monitoring inclusive education in the Sarajevo Canton;
- Developed and adopted an innovative model of monitoring inclusive education;
- Installed software in the association "Life with Down Syndrome" containing data on children with special educational needs;
- Created Report on the state and needs of the children with special educational needs in inclusive education system in the Sarajevo Canton;
- Organized one day event for 138 pupils with 5 educational workshops for the children in primary schools from the Sarajevo Canton;
- Organized a public debate of the representatives of the competent ministry, faculties, schools, specialized institutions and civil society organizations, which has improved cooperation in solving problems of children with learning difficulties;
- Organized public presentation of the project and its results which refer to the Report on the state and needs of the children with special needs in inclusive educational process.
